- Offer a second season of shows by EXPRESS ENTERTAINMENT for our adult performers and audiences.
- Increase programming for preschoolers and day care centers with shorter shows, puppet theatre and creative classes.
- Expand theatre class offerings from one semester to three semesters each year.
- Provide a home for the expansion of the New Playwright's Competition.
- Encourage small performance troupes in improv and experimental theatre.
- Provide the community with a small venue that can be used for meetings, receptions, bands, parties and other gatherings.
- Increase variety of theatre offerings and related events like fashion shows, dinner theatre, seminars, competitions and more!

Why we need your help



Eau Claire currently has a limited number of smaller performance spaces. While ECCT is committed to, and will continue to, perform at the State Theatre with the larger Broadway musicals, there are a number of shows that are just too small for an 1100 seat theatre. Some smaller shows require a much more intimate setting, while other critically acclaimed works have a more limited audience appeal, and yet there are others that require audience interaction. In addition to increasing the variety of show offered, popular shows could run for multiple weekends. This space would also give younger performers a chance to rehearse in their actual performance space. There have been many ideas suggested to ECCT on what types of programming it could offer - unfortunately, the answer is too often, "there's no place to do that".
