CAPITAL CAMPAIGN CONTINUES

The price tag for The Oxford is \$500,000. Current fundraising stands at just over \$145,000 in cash and pledges. We are pleased to announce that the L.E. Phillips Family Foundation has awarded ECCT a \$100,000 challenge grant to be awarded in October of next year, 2011, if we can raise another \$255,000 by that time. This would bring us to the \$500,000 needed to pay off the project and allow more funds to be used for new programming, shows and projects. 
