#### **The Rules**

- The competition is open to all Northern Wisconsin residents in two age categories: 8-14 years old and 15 years old-Adult. The first 60 acts to submit their completed entry form and fee will be allowed to compete. The first place winners from last year's event are ineligible unless they've moved into the next age category.
- Acts can be solos, duos, or groups. Groups may have a maximum of 10 members.
- Performances can be anything singing, dancing, juggling, magic tricks, etc. but must be limited to 4 minutes or less. The judges may stop your performance at any time.
- Area professionals will judge performers during the semi-final rounds July 11-13 and select contestants to
  move on to the finals on July 14. The competition will run from 5-7 p.m. each evening at the Northern
  Wisconsin State Fair. You will be assigned to one of the three semi-final competition dates based on your age
  and type of act.
- The number of finalists chosen each evening may vary, and all judges' decisions are final.
- A sound system with two microphones, a piano, and CD player will be available on stage. You must provide
  your own accompanist or recorded accompaniment and any other materials needed for your act. Please make
  sure your CD works in a CD player, not just on your computer.
- At the finals, judges will select a winner and two runners-up in each age category. Over \$500 in cash and prizes will be awarded to the winners.

#### **Important Dates**

- Entry deadline: Friday, June 29, 2012, by 5 p.m.
- Semi-Finals Date Assignments: Emailed to entrants on Monday, July 2, 2012.
- **Semi-Finals:** July 11, 12, 13, 2012, from 5-7 p.m. at the Northern Wisconsin State Fair. You will be assigned to one of these three dates based on your age and type of act.
- Finals: Saturday, July 14, 2012, at 5 p.m. at the Northern Wisconsin State Fair.
