OUR SOLUTION

The ECCT Board has adopted a resolution to purchase the property at 1814 Oxford Avenue. This downtown property as defined in the Hyatt-Palma study will help ECCT meet the challenges we outlined. This property will allow ECCT to provide more services and offer multiple programming options simultaneously with expanded rehearsal and classroom spaces, with plenty of room for storage. The 1.4 acre lot will allow for the future addition of rehearsal/performance spaces. As arts community leaders we also want to be involved in the community that supports us by taking a larger role in downtown redevelopment.

OUR CAMPAIGN PROFILE

The goal of our fundraising effort is \$350,000 which includes the purchase of the building and necessary renovations. Renovations include upgrading of HVAC systems, adding handicapped restrooms, insulating for energy efficiency and constructing walls to create spaces to meet our program needs.

The timeline for raising the funds is as such:

- May 3, 2007- \$8,000 in earnest money to owners- remodeling starts
- June 11, 2007- \$80,000 due at closing
- Aug. 31, 2007- \$50,000 for necessary renovations- occupancy on this date
- Dec. 31, 2007- \$42,000 to complete 20% of bank payoff
- June 1, 2008- \$85,000 for 50% of bank payoff
- June 1, 2009- \$85,000 to complete bank payoff

Time is of the essence as outlined above; however we are prepared to take pledges for up to a three-year period and set up installment payments as needed. We are also able to accept donations of stocks and other securities and will also be looking for connections to in-kind donations of products and services.

OUR CHALLENGE

Over the last 18 years, ECCT has experienced tremendous growth in the number of patrons served, the number of students taking classes and the number of productions, special events and season extras being presented. Since May, 1994, the group has been in a leased space at 18 S. Barstow Street (The Theatre Annex) for offices, rehearsals, classes and storage. Set construction takes place in the basement of the State Theatre: the costume shop, initially housed in the Annex, was moved into its own space next door in 2000. In 2001 the ECCT Board initiated a search for the purchase of a commercial space that would allow the group to adequately meet the growing needs of the organization and allow for future expansion.

Over the last six years the search for a building has continued in an attempt to meet four challenges facing ECCT in its current space:

* Lack of classroom space- the current location does not provide adequate space to offer any more than two classes or workshops at one time, limiting the number of classes offered and thus the number of participants.

* Lack of rehearsal space- there is now space to run two concurrent rehearsals. With recent increases in programming it has been necessary to send volunteers to other locations to rehearse, as space was not available for them.

* Lack of storage space- the storage capacity of the current location has been maximized with no options for future expansion

* Lack of performance space- there is no performance space or potential for expansion, particularly for smaller productions targeting our youngest audience members.
